

**MINUTES

The South Carolina Education Lottery Commission held a teleconference meeting at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 5, 2005, originating in the fourth floor conference room of SCEL's headquarters building, 1333 Main Street, Columbia, South Carolina, with the following Commissioners participating:

Dr. Edward Keith was unable to participate. The Chair called the meeting to order.

**Proposed Powerball Changes**

The Powerball Game Group of the Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) has considered various changes to the Powerball game and recommend the following:

- Increase the numbers from 53 to 55 by adding two balls to the white ball pool, changing the odds of winning to 1 in 146,000,000
- Increase the size of the minimum jackpot from \$10 million to \$15 million and increase the jackpot size in increments of \$5 million
- Provide for graduated annuity payments (increasing each year) over the same number of years
- Increase match-5 prizes from \$100,000 to \$200,000
- Add a 10-times multiplier as a promotional feature of Power Play to be offered periodically beginning January 2006 for a thirty-day period or until a 10x multiplier hits.

These changes have been recommended in response to player feedback requesting higher jackpots, a faster rate of growth and higher non-jackpot prizes.

**Motion Adopted**

Commissioner Burriss moved to authorize the Executive Director to take all appropriate action necessary to implement the changes to the Powerball game. Commissioner Madden seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously adopted.

**Other Business**

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
